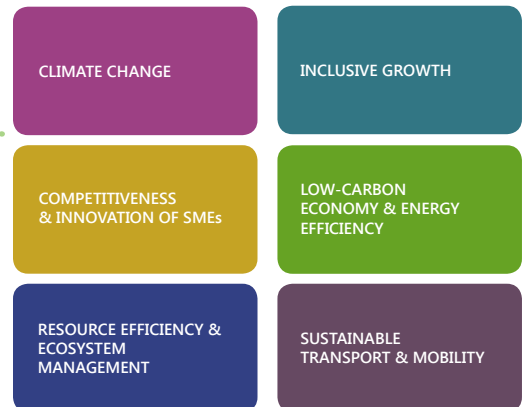

PROMOTING POLICY

With its long tradition in transnational cooperation, the programme has helped to shape the political agenda in the Alpine Space. Its projects have impacted policies at all levels and in all stages from development to implementation.

From 2011 to 2013, the programme carried out a strategy development project and stakeholder consultation process, which provided an important evidence base for the long-term strategic policy orientation in the Alpine Space. Its results contributed to the development of the macroregional strategy for the Alpine region (EUSALP).

Projects co-funded by the Alpine Space Programme have created long-term benefits in the programme area and even beyond.

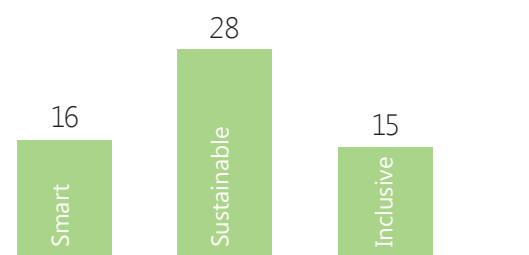
How sustainable are buildings in Europe?
