**14:00:** Meeting at Haus der Berge, public transportation to Wimbachbrücke, Ramsau

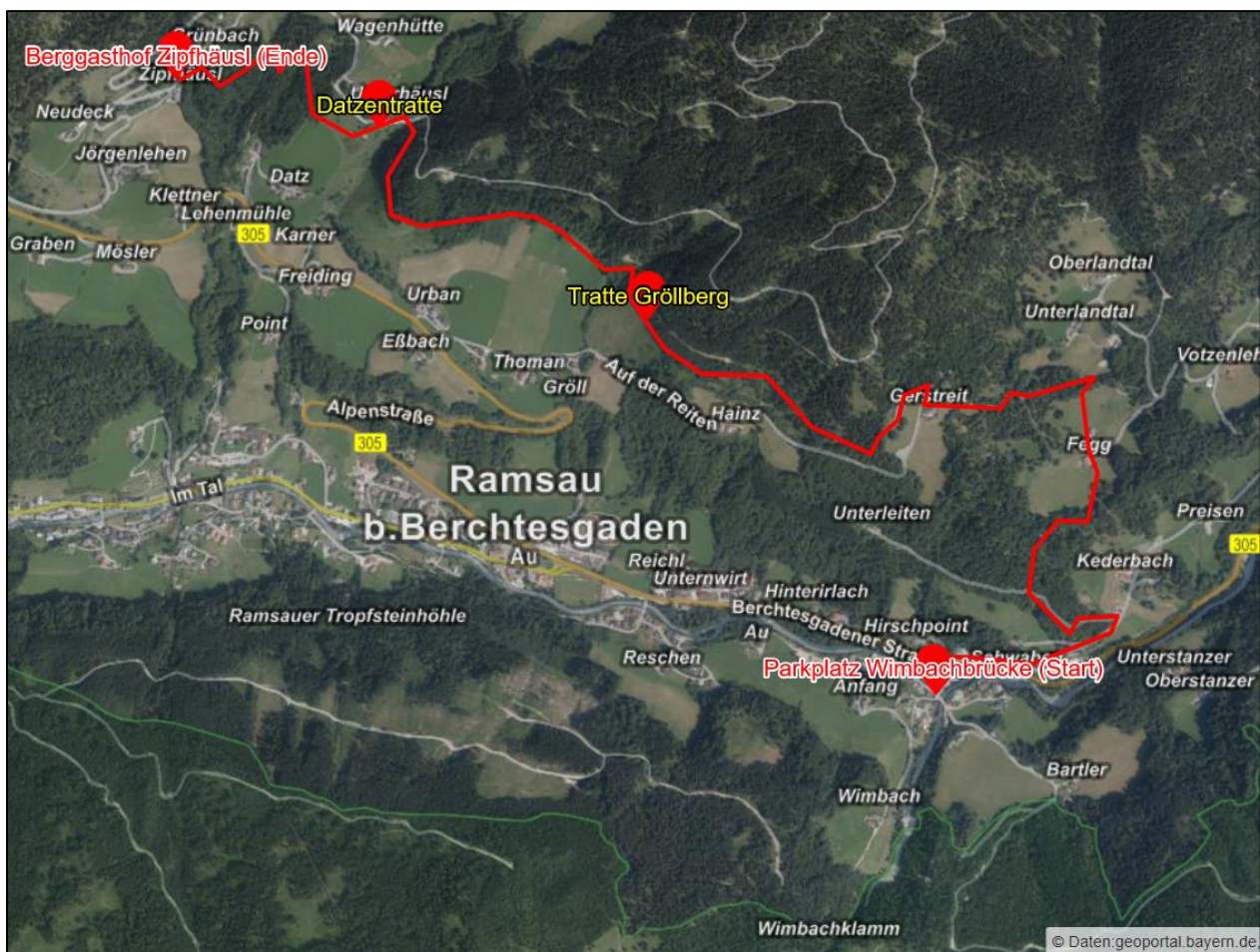
**15:00:** Light hiking tour from Wimbachbrücke via Soleleitungsweg to “Gasthaus Zipfhäusl”

- 1) Field visit of the “Tratten”, a special feature of cultural landscape and local Strategic Alpine Connectivity Area (SACA). Landcare Germany gives information on planned ecological measures (removal of shrubs and extensive grazing). Distance 5,5 kilometers, duration of walk ca. 2 hours. Solid shoes and condition for 300 metre difference in altitude required.

- 2) Nationalpark Berchtesgaden offers transportation with small buses (max. 15 persons) from Haus der Berge to Gasthaus Zipfhäusl for participants with physical disabilities. From there flat walk on the Soleleitungsweg to the “Tratten” (ca. 30 minutes).
