### **Background**

- New demands and challenges for the logistic market under the preconditions of the economic crisis
- Increasing prices for oil and rigorous ecologic demands
- Constantly and rapidly growing freight traffic on the road
- Unused potentials for alternative traffic carriers or combined solutions
- Bottleneck function of the Alpine Space due to geologic conditions

### **Objectives**

- Create sustainable intermodal solutions for transalpine freight traffic to fit changing markets
- Improve the railway network's attractiveness and accessibility for the logistic market
- Disburden alpine transport routes and generate positive ecologic and economic impacts
- Implement the shift from road to rail related traffic
- Activate synergies and leverage effects through transnational cooperation

### **Measures**

- Development and implementation of reliable transnational rail products for accompanied and unaccompanied combined transport in close cooperation with the logistic market.
- Optimization of intermodal nodes
- Development of new train connections and rail services for transalpine freight transport
- Proactive promotion and support of the railway system among all relevant stakeholders; close collaboration with politicians, players from the logistic sector as well as similar projects.
