Background and aim of the final conference

Services of general interest (SGI) are in the competence of authorities at different levels. Up to now, authorities and the service providers tend to have a strictly sectorial approach to SGI which leads to isolated solutions, neither taking benefit of potential synergies nor optimizing the expense of public money. In the last 3 years the INTESI Interreg Alpine Space project was involving 10 partners in 5 countries - with the main aim to assure the delivery of services of general interest (SGI) in the long run via integrated, territorial strategies and policies.

During this time the INTESI project achieved the following steps:

- A collection and analysis of all SGI strategies in the entire Alpine space relevant for SGI delivery
- An assessment of the status quo of SGI delivery and challenges, needs and potentials in 10 test areas.
- The implementation of 8 pilot activities in order to test SGI strategies and to improve the offer of SGI delivery
- A set of recommendations and a model towards integration of the SGI provision strategies.
- An Alpine think tank composed of 16 experts, where issues of service delivery in the Alpine Space are discussed half yearly.

The final conference on the 9th of October 2018 aims to present the achievements of the INTESI approach, sharing the experiences among the participants and exploring ways forward in better implementing an integrated SGI approach on a practical level as well as on a political level. It will bring together representatives from regions, municipalities and cities, public administration officers, policy makers, practitioners, and experts from the EU to the local level.

This project is co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) through the Interreg Alpine Space programme.

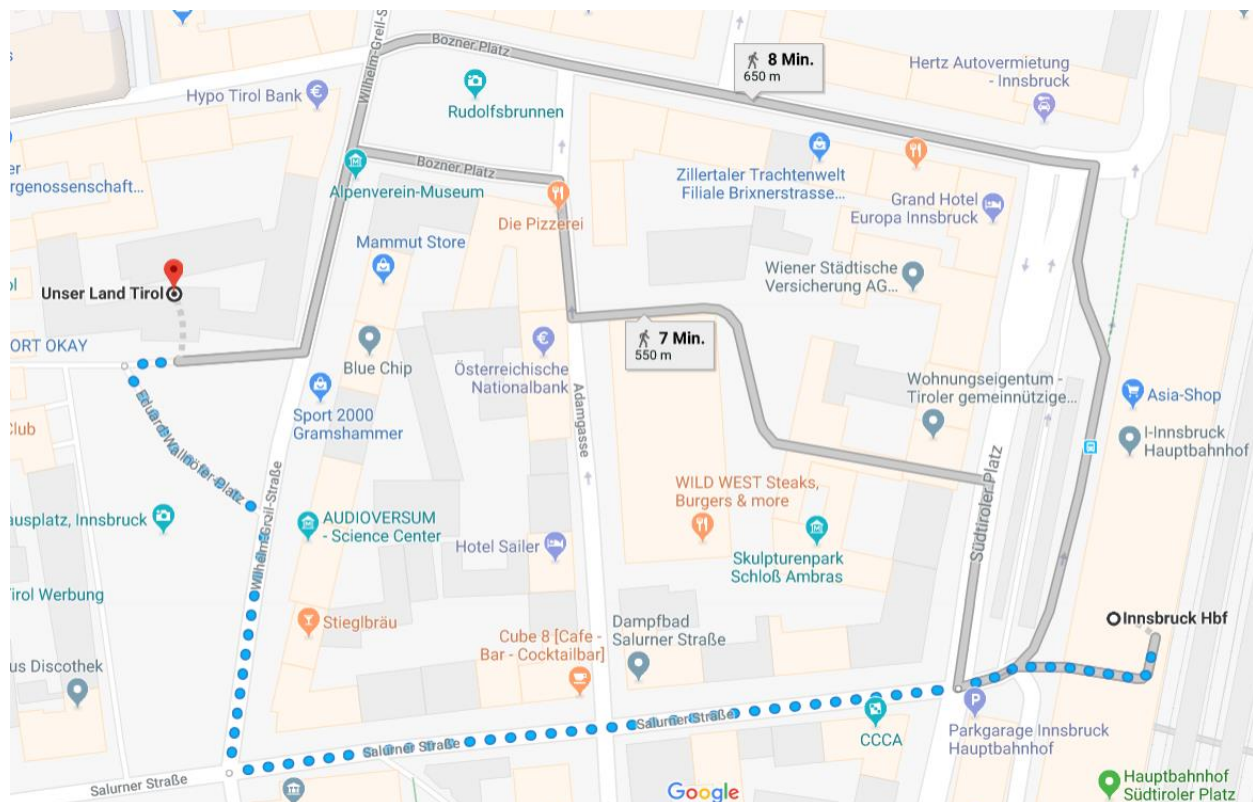
