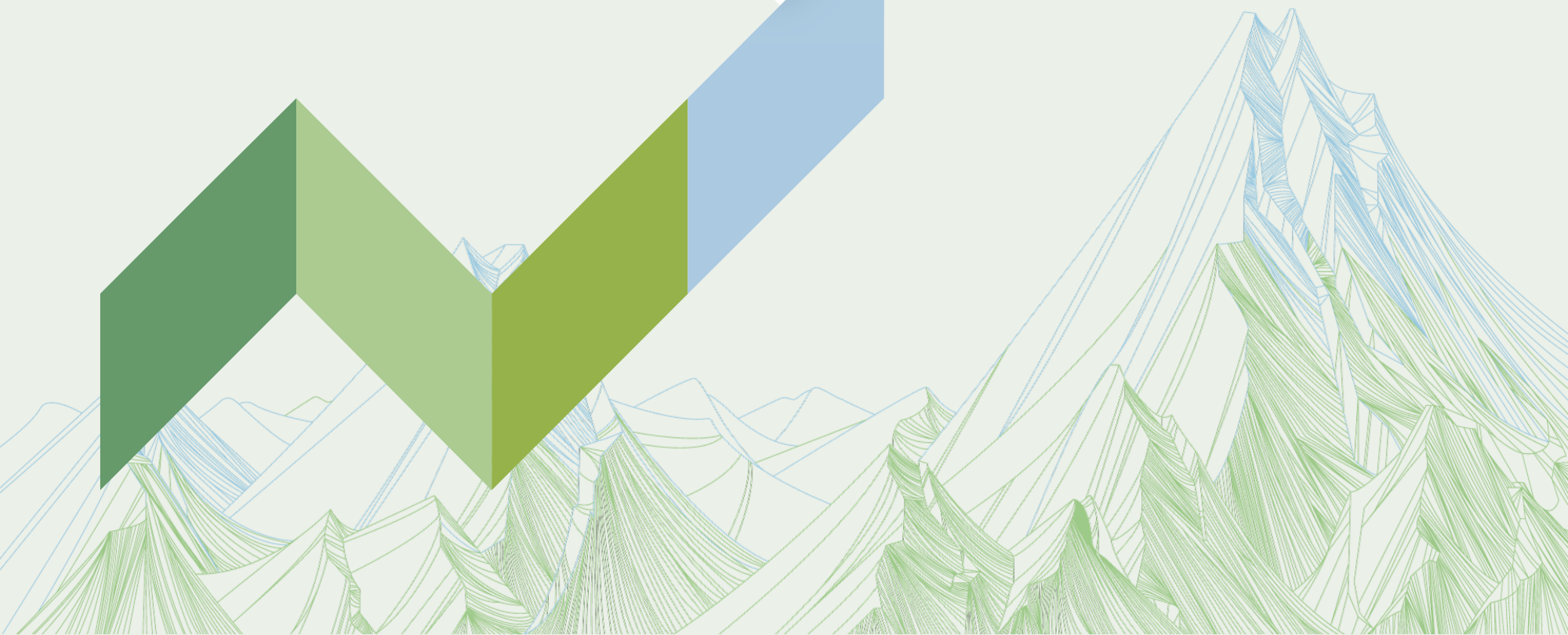

# Partnership agreement (PA)

---



## Partnership agreement

- Foreseen by EU regulations (2021/1059 art. 26)
- Regulates relationship between all partners (incl. LP) for project implementation
- Recalls EU and programme rules for funds and project management
- The programme only needs a scan of the signed partnership agreement
- To be uploaded in Jems (section “Application annexes”)

# PA - Template and entry into force

---



There are 2 templates:

1. For EU member states: majority of projects, when the lead partner comes from a EU country
2. Other: when the lead partner is from Switzerland or Liechtenstein and supported by a EU country for the project financial management

Make sure you select the right one for you!

# PA - Template and entry into force



Templates with minimum clauses provided on programme website



To be filled in with project data



Additional clauses may be added. In this case, please send your draft to [alpine.space@salzburg.gv.at](mailto:alpine.space@salzburg.gv.at) (MA) at least 15 days before project submission deadline

Entry into force upon signature by all PP and **project approval**

# PA - Procedure



- If signing difficulties are encountered, please inform [js@alpine-space.eu](mailto:js@alpine-space.eu) (JS) well in advance and before the deadline for the submission
- Make sure each project participant receives one original
- Up to the partnership to decide how to sign, but 3rd option easiest and recommended. Be reminded of date of signature for each PP!
- E-signature possible if foreseen by national law/internal rules of PP
- Upload all signed PA in JEMS
