

- National control system Austria decentralized
 - Control only by nominated controllers (predefined list)

- Establishment of a financing agreement between the partner and the Confederation.
- Annual invoices.
- Activity report, list of income and expenditures and independent review report at the end of the project.

National control system: Germany



First Level Control (FLC): Decentralised system

The beneficiary is free to appoint its controller, but the latter must be authorized by the StMUV (Bavarian State Ministry of the environment and consumer protection).

Precondition for the authorization is the proof that the controller is personally and functionally independent from the benificiary to be controlled.

According to Article 46(8) and (9) of regulation (EU) 2021/1059 controllers shall meet the following requirements:

- either a <u>national or regional authority</u> or a <u>private body</u> or a <u>natural person</u>
- in case of a private body or a natural person: be a <u>member of a national accounting</u> or <u>auditing body</u> <u>or institution</u> (which is a member of International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) or is at least committing to carry out the management verifications in accordance with IFAC standards and ethics)
- \rightarrow <u>New for 2021-2027</u>: internal control units of local authorities no longer possible

FRANCE



National control system: France



- Each beneficiary still chooses his or her controller and contracts directly with them
- NEW: in order to simplify the process, the National Authority will carry out a preliminary selection in order to propose a shortlist of 4-5 auditors from which the beneficiaries can choose
- This procedure will apply to all beneficiaries, whether public or private
- A more detailed procedure will be communicated to French beneficiaries in the near future

How to get a FLC



- Each Italian project beneficiary must select its own First Level Controller to certify the expenses incurred and reported
- The choice is up to each beneficiary individually
- There are no rosters to draw from
- The execution of the checks must be entrusted to controllers designated among qualified subjects, in possession of the necessary requisites of professionalism, integrity, independence and knowledge of the English language
- Furthermore, the controller must have been enrolled, for not less than three years, in the "Albo dei Dottori Commercialisti e degli Esperti Contabili"





A First Level Controller can be of two types:

- Internal certifier: Admitted exclusively for public administrations. The beneficiary identifies the internal office that will carry out the activity of control. Functional independence must be respected between the office responsible for initiating and implementing the operation (beneficiary) and the office responsible for payments.
- External certifier: The beneficiary selects its First Level Controller through public procurement (see Legislative Decree no. 50/2016). It can be a person or a company





- Each First Level Controller, before being able to operate, must be officially authorized by the national coordinating body (Commissione Mista)
- This authorization usually takes place within 5 months from the approval of the project
- The authorizations are valid from time to time for only one specific project. This means that if a partner participates in several projects always making use of the same first level controller, it needs as many authorizations as the projects in which it participates.



Documentation to be submitted to identify and contract a FLC (1/2)



- The Commissione Mista has prepared the instructions, requirements and forms to be used for identifying and contracting the First Level Controllers
- To request the authorization of its controller, the beneficiary sends the specific documentation to the National Contact Point
- NCP sends these documents to the Commissione Mista that verified the completeness of the documents for the authorization



Documentation to be submitted to identify and contract a FLC (2/2)



- The person who signs the documentation must be the same indicated in the Application Form as the legal representative
- Usually the Commissione Mista gives the authorization within 10 days from the submission of the application
- Once authorized by the Commissione Mista each first level controller must profile itself on the JeMS by creating its own user
- From that moment the user is associated with the project. The controller can proceed with the certification of the expenses reported



Form to be filled by FLC



- According to the type of FLC, the following documents must be provided:
 - All. 3 indipendenza_funzionale
 - All.1a richiesta per controllore interno
 - All.1b richiesta per controllore esterno
 - All.2 scheda informativa_2
 - All.4 conoscenza_lingua inglese
 - All.5 certificazione controllore esterno (individuale)
 - All.6 certificazione controllore esterno (società)
 - All.7 atto notorio controllore individuale
 - All.9 autorizzazione trattamento dati (individuale)
 - All.10 autorizzazione trattamento dati (società)
 - All.A Requisiti controllori primo livello

- Responsible body: Government Office for Development and EU cohesion.
- No costs for the execution of first level controls will be charged to the projects.
- Guaranteed smooth implementation of the controls and cooperation with the MA/JS/ACP, the national authority and beneficiaries will be ensured.
