

Some points for discussion

- Lead applicant should be an institution experienced in the management of projects supported by EU funds
- Pool all skills and competences of relevant institutions necessary to address the issues tackled by the project in order to achieve the set objectives
- Both vertical and horizontal integration is therefore expected to help reaching the intented structural change as well policy improvement and implementation
- Apply result-oriented approach by involving institutions -- either as partners or observers -- who are supposed to developed and implement the project outputs and results
- External expertise could be sought to complement and bridge knowledge gaps





Project experience by GRETA

- €2.3m of ERDF funding for a 36-month project in Priority 2 under SO
 2.1
- Demonstrate the potential of near-surface geothermal energy in the programme area and foster its integration into energy plans at different administrative levels
- 12 project partners from 6 partner countries whose sector of activity ranges from academia to public authorities and business support organisations
- 21 observers, e.g. European Geothermal Energy Council, German Geothernal Association, Slovenian Ministry of Infrastructures, Bavarian Environmental Agency



- You have to know the role of the partner in the country
 - Use the knowledge of your partners



- **Budget issues**

- balance between partners and countries

Evaluate with National Contact Point


Stakeholder Analysis
