This means workflows should be done again and again until there is no eventuality left. ○ How can this identified problems be solved. <p>IML will work out different process chains and provide the team with them.</p> <p>bHG will sent the process list to the port of Triest</p>
Third part	<p>Third part – The Wishlist Workshop</p> <p>There are 4 main participants for the ideal process:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Terminaloperator ➔ Rail operator ➔ Forwarder ➔ Production
	<p>“Greenfield Wishlist”</p> <p>The Wishlist should be set up as a greenfield concept.</p> <p>Definition of the following KPIs were decided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Operational performance ➔ Customer satisfaction ➔ Financial performance ➔ Environmental performance <p>If there are wishes for further KPIs, this can be mentioned afterwards by all project partners until the 02. February 2018. SGKV will implement these wishes afterwards.</p>
	<p>The most important points were worked out by the Meeting-Partners point of view. Every partner made his contribution to the workshop. All points were discussed and written on the board. If there are further wishes this can be mentioned by all project</p>

February and will be implemented afterwards.</p> <p>This information will be the basis for the work which is carried out by IML Fraunhofer and SGKV within WP T3.</p> <p>The wishes should be prioritized as followed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Process Level 1 ➔ should be checked in general ➔ Process Level 2 ➔ should be checked if there is a problem or an effect to. This means, it should be pointed out if there is an effect and to what this effect replies to. <p>The writings on the board are attached and uploaded in the AlpInnoCT-Cloud. Further points can be added if this is necessary by all project partners.</p>
