ASTUS's overall objective is to reduce in a long term perspective the CO2 emissions of daily mobility in the Alps by helping local authorities to identify a set of relevant transport options and spatial planning measures that have a positive impact on household's mobility.

ASTUS Final Conference

The ASTUS Final conference took place on 15 October 2019 in Ljubljana and Novo Mesto (Slovenia). The event, hosted by the Urban Planning Institute of the Republic of Slovenia (UIRS), gathered more than 50 participants.



The outcomes and results of the project were presented during the conference. The participants had the opportunity to acquaint themselves with decision-making tools for low carbon scenarios in transport and land use planning developed in the project. ASTUS partners invited external experts working on similar projects to contribute their reflections.

The conference was also a place for exchange and for getting inspired about mobility and spatial planning solutions. ASTUS pilot sites representatives participated in the conference and presented the topics addressed, solutions developed in their territories and the lessons learnt in the frame of ASTUS.

The conference ended with an excursion to Novo Mesto with sighting of the wider area as well as a visit to the historic town centre and a presentation of mobility related projects in the municipality.
