Mapping and analysis of the forest production capacity and economic potential for a subset of Forest Ecosystem Services (FES), in order to **delineate business models and market frameworks in the Alpine region.**



Explore the need for innovative policies and elaborate a **proposal for policy actions** to foster and facilitate forest maintenance, FES markets development and new value chains.



Test, validate and refine the proposed **models and tools in pilot areas**, following a living lab approach, and **involving local community players.** The results of each national living lab will be compared at a transnational
