## OFFICIAL KICK-OFF MEETING

<u>September 12, 2024</u>

The DiMark project was officially launched at the National Institute of Biology (NIB), with 11 partners from 6 countries. The meeting, attended by 30 representatives from 10 public institutions focused on communication strategies, financial management, and the objectives of the project.

featured alongside the ALGA Interreg project at the Cluster Eau Seminar, organized in partnership with the European Space Agency. The seminar focused on satellite technologies for


sustainable water management, offering a platform to highlight DiMark's role in addressing climate-related water risks in the Alpine region.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE 1D

DiMark Project Partner, the Swiss research institute EAWAG,

has developed a onedimensional (1D) hydrological model for DiMark's key lakes. This tool provides accurate, real-time lake information and

predictions across the European Alps, helping local communities, visitors, environmental scientists, and lake managers make proactive water management decisions.
