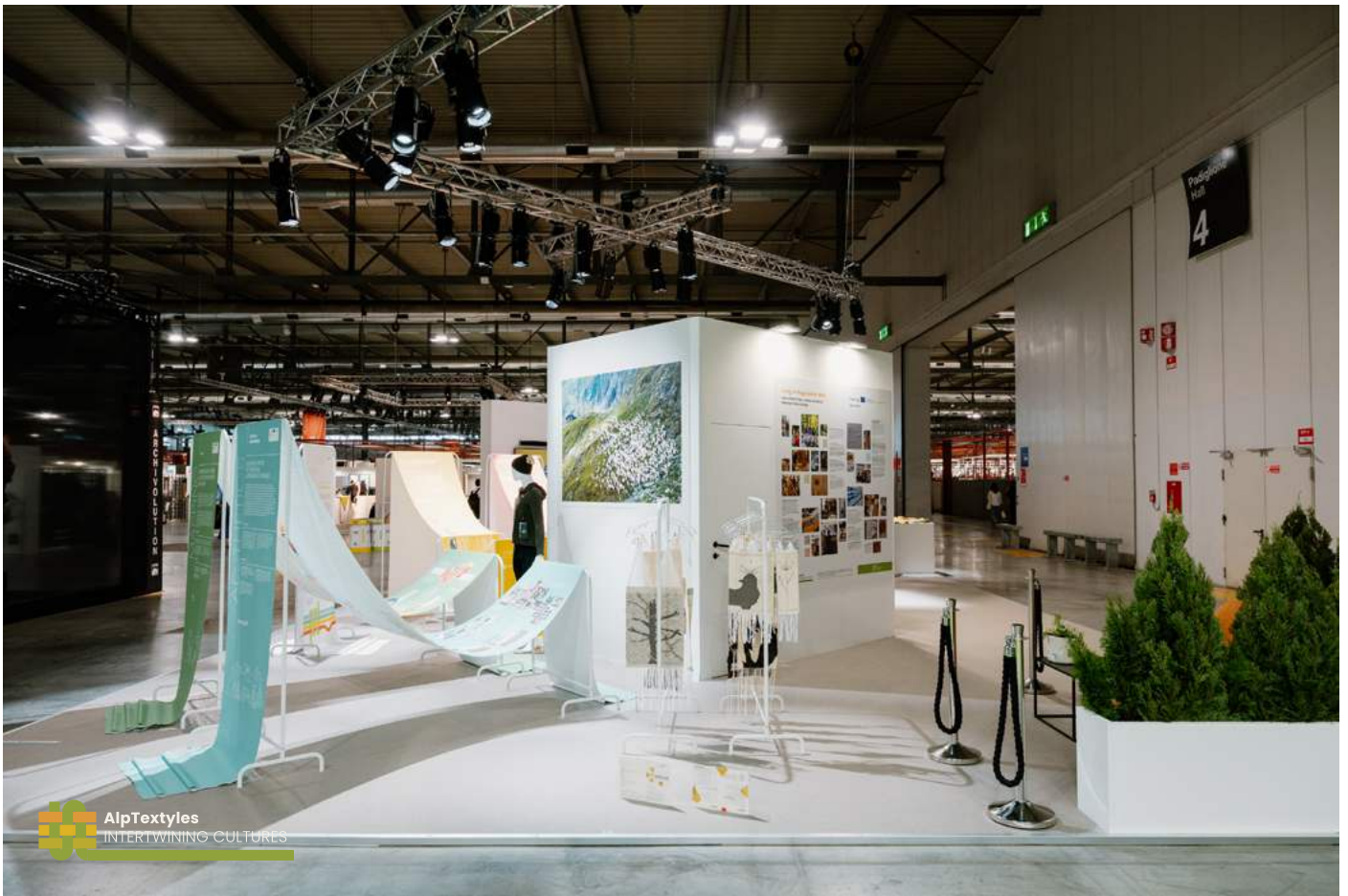


The craft of future fabric
